


The 2023 edition of the Finance in Common Summit (FiCS)

will take place September 4th to 6th in Cartagena, Colombia. It will bring together representatives of Public Development Banks (PDBs) from all around the world and their key partners to highlight the pivotal role they play towards a more inclusive and sustainable financial system.

Directors and representatives of various development financial institutions, government delegations, representatives of international organizations, civil society, among others, will participate in the event.

This Handbook for Delegates provides guidelines for participants on Summit-related issues such as: schedule, credentials, airports, transportation, lodging, liaisons, platforms, communications, health, security, press, among others.

The FiCS Organizing Committee fully commits all its capabilities to ensure a successful event and the expected outcomes for all participants.



Language

Spanish is the official language of the Republic of Colombia.


Local time Colombian standard time is 5 hours behind Greenwich Mean Time (-5GMT).

Power Supply

The power supply in Colombia is 110V, 60 cycles (60hz). Therefore, we recommend having transformers and adapters as necessary. There are two types of outlets:



Temperature

The average temperature in Cartagena de Indias is 28° C (80° F), and humidity is 81%.

FICS 2023 Summit Venue

The main venue for FiCS 2023 will be the Cartagena de Indias Convention Center, located in the Getsemani neighborhood.

Immigration

To enter Colombia, visitors must hold a valid passport. No vaccination card is required.

Currency

Colombia's local currency is the Colombian Peso. Its official exchange rate varies from day to day. We recommend checking the exchange rate (TRM) of the day.

Taxes

All purchases in Colombia are subject to a 19% Value Added Tax (VAT).



Tips

Tipping in Colombia is voluntary. The custom is to tip 10% of the total value of the bill at bars and restaurants. Businesses usually include this percentage in the bill, with prior consent.

Organizing Committee

The organizing committee is composed of the Latin American Association of Development Financial Institutions (ALIDE), the Colombian Development Bank (Bancóldex), the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), the Latin American and Caribean Development Bank (CAF), and the Europeanlinvestment Bank (EIB), together with the FiCS secretariat.

Credentials

The participation in FiCS 2023 is coordinated by the FiCS Secretariat together with the co-organizers of the event, who directly invite governmentsinternational organizations, development banks, social organizations, academia, and others.

On-site participation is subject to confirmation by the organizers, due to limited capacity.

Access to the Convention Center will be subject to entry restrictions and security controls.

Credentials will be handed out starting September 3 at 2:00 p.m., at the modules located at the outside entrance of the Convention Center.

Participants who would like to receive their credentials the day before the event may do so, and transportation will be available from the host hotels for this purpose. Please note that credentials are personal and non-transferable, must be worn at all times and only one will be issued per participant. Airport

Participants may use our luggage storage service during the event's scheduled hours.

Press

Media outlets are required to be accredited by the organization for FiCS 2023 media coverage, either for in-person or virtual participation.

During the event, accredited media will have access to the Press Room in the Pegasus Hall, which has all the tools to facilitate the work of journalists.

Medical Services

The Convention Center is equipped with a medical first aid station with specialized personnel, as well as medical transportation in the event any participant needs to be transferred to a higher level of care.

In such cases, patients will be taken to the Serena del Mar Hospital Center, located 20 minutes away from the event site. Basic health care services will also be provided at the hotels with on-site services.

Safety and Facilities

The Convention Center relies on its own security system for participants. The National Police will also be on site to support the event.

Access will not be allowed to persons and vehicles without proper accreditation from FiCS.

Food

Participants will enjoy refreshments during the event in between sessions, as well as lunches during the days of the agenda.

Also, coffee stations and permanent refreshment stands will be available.

Urban Transportation

Due to its urban characteristics, it is easy to get around the city of Cartagena de Indias through its central districts, which include the Walled City, Bocagrande, Getsemani, Castillo Grande, and Manga.

Cabs in Cartagena do not have a meter, and the fare is based on a rate chart determined by the distance of the trip.
